About The Program

Children's Connection, a program of the Human Services Council, uses intervention, education and support to address the issue of child abuse while striving towards its mission...

**to create a world where no child is harmed
and no family is left without guidance.**

Children's Connection is a fully accredited Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) which provides a comfortable, private, child-friendly setting that is both physically and emotionally safe for children of all ages.

The purpose of a CAC is to provide a coordinated, collaborative multidisciplinary team (MDT) to respond to allegations of child abuse. An effective MDT is an essential component in the investigation, management, and prosecution of child abuse cases.

The MDT and CAC integrate and coordinate the services of all the agencies in a way that does not intimidate or re-victimize children while increasing prosecution rates to hold more offenders accountable for their actions.

For seven decades, the Human Services Council (HSC) has identified unmet community needs and "filled the gaps" by creating and fostering programs that educate, safeguard, and empower the people of our community. Collaborating with local not-for-profits, HSC positively impacts over 8,000 children, families, and individuals each year.
